

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer or other device by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the website.

Information we collect through this website

Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation ('we' or the 'Corporation') collects personal data about visitors to its websites [www.dicgc.org.in](http://www.dicgc.org.in). When someone visits our websites, we will use a third party service, to collect standard internet log information (such as IP address and type of browser user's use), user behavior patterns, measure how you use the website so it can be updated and improved based on your needs, remember preferences you've chosen such as language. We do this to allow us to keep track of the number of visitors to the various parts of the sites and understand how our website is used. We do not make any attempt to find out the identities or nature of those visiting our websites. Cookies will not be used to identify you personally, or to track your behavior on other sites.

By using this website, you consent to having its cookies placed on your device – unless you have disabled them. For help managing cookies, consult the settings for your web browser.

In any instance where we collect personal data through our websites, we will make this clear and will set out how we will use this. We will only use your personal data in a way that is compatible with the uses outlined to you, except where it's obliged for us to do otherwise.

Information we collect through Matomo

We use Matomo Analytics software to collect data such as website traffic, page views, and user interactions information about how you use the website. Matomo can be configured to anonymize IP addresses, and it generally doesn't collect personally identifiable information unless explicitly provided by the website owner, like in custom variables.

We do this to make sure the site is meeting the needs of its user's requirement.

Basic parameters in website analytics data include:

- Frequency of visitor on website.
- Unique visitors visited on website.
- Referral sources
- Bounce rates

- User engagement metrics

#### Managing or removing cookies

#### IP Address

Web servers automatically collect information about visits to a website, including the visitor's Internet Protocol (IP) address. IP addresses are unique numbers assigned to all devices used to access the Internet. The IP address, on its own, does not identify an individual. However, in certain circumstances, such as with the co-operation of an ISP for example, it could be used to identify an individual using the site.

#### Personal information communicated via the website or by email

We collect further personal data only with your consent, such as an email address if you wish to sign up to a mailing list. The relevant pages provide more information about the personal data we collect.
